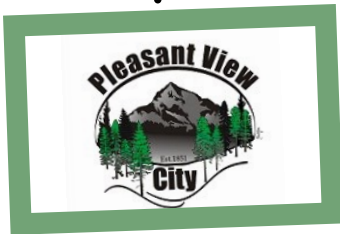
The following positions are to be filled at the **2017 Pleasant View City’s Municipal Elections:**

Qualifications for a candidate are:

1. Registered voter.
2. Resident of the Pleasant View for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
3. No mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored.

To become a candidate a Declaration of Candidacy shall be filed in person at the City Hall between June 1st and 7th on Monday thru Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

P.V. City CERT NEIGHBORHOOD ACTIVITY JUNE 22, 2017—6:30 P.M. At your neighborhood gathering place

This year's neighborhood activity will focus on treatment areas. Treatment areas are placed where those injured in a disaster are gathered to receive the best medical care and transport to medical facilities. This requires cooperation between CERT and professional responders and will work more smoothly if practiced beforehand. This year, for the first time ever, North View Fire Department will participate in the activity. North View will provide the professionals; the residents of Pleasant View must provide the victims. All block captains will be asked to bring at least one person from their block to be a victim at the treatment area. Block captains will ask for volunteer victims that night at their block gathering places. They will provide fake wounds and arrange transportation to and from the treatment area, where victims will receive care from CERT as well as professionals. Please consider being a victim. It will take about an hour and be a great learning experience for everyone involved. We'll need lots of victims to justify the involvement of North View and make the activity a valuable training exercise for the CERT Team. Remember, this program exists to provide help to YOU in a disaster situation. It can provide the greatest amount of good only with YOUR support. Please go to your gathering place on June 22nd at 6:30 P.M. You will receive more information about treatment areas from your block captain. If you are not contacted by a block captain but would like to participate in the activity, please send your name to PVCERT@comcast.net.
