Winter Parking

From November 15th to March 15th it is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, any other vehicle, or object of any kind, on any public street or right of way while snow plows are operating or while streets are snow or ice covered. In other words, *if there's even a chance of snow, please make sure you have parked all motor vehicles, trailers and any other vehicles off of the public street!*
