WEBER COUNTY GREEN WASTE FACILITY


The Green Waste facility at the Weber County Transfer Station located at 867 Wilson Lane in West Haven is also available for your yard clean-up waste for a fee.

PLEASANT VIEW PICKLEBALL COURTS


Pleasant View City is continuing to work in collaboration with the Pleasant View Pickleball Association (PVPA) to move forward with project planning and securing the necessary funding for the new Pickleball Tournament Courts. Nine additional courts are planned to be installed at Pleasant View Park. The City was recently awarded \$477,700 through a Weber County RAMP grant and several local business owners and residents have stepped up in a big way to contribute to the project through monetary and in-kind donations. With other grant applications under review, the City is hoping that additional funding can soon be secured to allow the project to move forward. Private donations are being actively accepted by PVPA.
