VOTING

Pleasant View City will not be holding a Primary Election. (A Primary Election would be needed if we had more than double the candidates for the number of seats open).



Pleasant View City has (3) three City Council seats open with (5) five candidates running for those seats. **The General Election will be held November 21st.**



Homes and businesses built prior to 1991 may include harmful materials, including lead, in the water main. The EPA has mandated an audit of all (1990 and older) City-connected water mains to check for potential lead exposure. Lines that are not self-reported will require an on-site inspection by Pleasant View City.
