It turned out to really be \$12 a square foot for an amount of \$77,544 which is the accurate number. We are still working with the contractor who installed the improvements. They are asking for ¼ million dollars with delays of 7 weeks of payment for a project that only lasted 6 weeks. The math doesn't work in this case. They then came back with 3 weeks of delays. The land purchased is on the east side of the expanded Rulon White to widen the road. We are purchasing it from the property owner.
