Business:

1. Discussion and possible action to award the Skyline Grading Package (Presenter: Amy Mabey)

Amy Mabey: we would like to get more information. We would like to set up meetings with the two lowest bidders to discuss other options. There is the option of

awarding the bid but there is an annual restraint or we can table this again until after the discussion with the two bidders. We have asked for a 60-day extension from both Staker Parson and C.E. Butters. Mayor Call: this died for lack of a motion and we will put this back on the agenda after the meeting with Staker Parson and C.E. Butters.

2. Discussion and possible action to amend the Field Reservation Policy, Policy 2021-2. (Presenter: Amy Mabey)

If it is a safety concern they should put in a right-turn only and they should try that for 1-2 years. I don't believe their goal is safety. We need to find out the real reason to close it. CM Marriott: they shouldn't do anything until there is a light. CM Urry: ask to see a traffic study.

<u>Amy Mabey</u>: the Easter Hunt is April 3rd. We need to figure out the event. What does the council want to see happen? Discussion from council on ideas.

<u>CM Marriott</u>: what are the survey results from the fiber survey? <u>CM Arrington</u>: so far there have been 221 responses. It closes March 15.

<u>CM Arrington</u>: the tree by the CERT house is causing problems.

<u>CM Bailey</u>: we got bids on the Veteran's Monument and it will be on the next agenda.

<u>CM Urry</u>: Ray Ward passed away. His daughter would like to start pickleball leagues.

<u>CM Gibson</u>: the Founder's Day meeting is Thursday at 3:30PM. It is a public meeting and not on zoom. We want a full-fledged Founder's Day. The car show is ready to go and all should be able to have the vaccine by then.
