### Skyline Dr.

- Engineering and property acquisition
- Additional funding requests with WFRC

### Culinary water

- Reservoir construction for Weber Basin Water
- Rate increase to fund construction
- Finish metering the sources to determine production
- Automatic meters to reduce loss and increase revenue
- Sewer— Relining/repair of our aging system
- Potential large increase from the Sewer District for nutrient removal

### Storm Water

- Continued management of our storm water
- Create maintenance agreements for both canals and systems and neighboring agencies
- Storm water rate increase for funding
- Construction of the washout containment facility
- Commercial Development
- Move the CDA forward with Farr West City
- Construct the new light on 2700 N.
- Construct the North section of Rulon White Blvd.

### Parks

- Finish construction of the Multi-Sports Complex, phase 1
- Apply for a grant for phase 2 and finish construction



### **Winter Parking**

From November 15th to March 15th it is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, any other vehicle, or object of any kind, on any public street or right of way while snow plows are operating or while streets are snow or ice covered. In other words, ***if there's even a chance of snow, please make sure you have parked all motor vehicles, trailers and any other vehicles off of the public street!***

### **Snow Removal Reminder**

It is unlawful to shovel or snow blow snow from sidewalks and driveways onto City roads. This creates traffic hazards and causes damage to the plow trucks, costing the entire citizenry unnecessary money. If noticed by the PVPD, such action can result in a citation.
