

Vote by Mail

Registered voters will be mailed a ballot. Your ballot will arrive about two weeks before Election Day, which is Tuesday, August 13th.

Ballots may be returned by mail or dropped at a ballot box. Your nearest ballot box is located at Pleasant View City Hall.

In addition, a vote center will be open on Election Day.

Early voting will be held at the Weber County Elections Office starting Wednesday, August 7, continuing Thursday, Friday and ending on Monday, August 12. This year, *I Voted Stickers* are included with the mailed ballots for all voters.

Reminder from the Storm Water Department

It's car washing season!! To prevent car washing products, such as soaps and detergent from entering our storm drain system from your driveways, if you must wash your car at home, try to do so on a grassy surface. The grass acts as a filter, removing most of the harmful contaminants before the remainder of the materials enter into the storm drain system.
